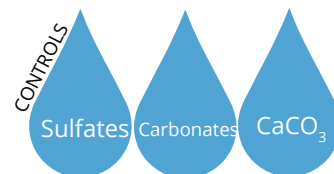


Pretreat Plus® 0100 Concentrate (Green)

It is specifically formulated for feedwaters with high levels of scale-forming minerals including sulfates and carbonates. Pretreat Plus® 0100 Concentrate (Green) is effective in controlling scale over a wide range of operating parameters.

Dosage

In the typical dosage range of 1–30 mg/L (as mixed), control of a wide range of inorganic scales at many more times the conventional saturation values. By monitoring the concentrate stream and trend charts using iWaterPRO™, optimal dosage can be achieved for the control of scales.

Application

Pretreat Plus® 0100 (Green) should be injected into the feed stream prior to the static mixer and cartridge filter. Do not allow product to freeze.
